


Edge: a percieved barrier.

The 33 and 198, in effect, have created a high-speed passage for people travelling in and out of the city and a barrier for people living on the East Side.

Likewise, The 190 creates a barrier of high speed traffic that **separates people on the West Side** from the scenic waterfront.

Village remain somewhat protected. However, in each case, proximity to high speed traffic increases exposure to pollutants, potential risk of collision and jeopardizes quality of life.
